

Year 6 Curriculum Overview

English						Maths					
Spelling – weekly spelling tests											
Reading – Children will continue to develop their responses to retrieval and inference questions and develop their answers using PEE – Point, Evidence and Explanation.											
Grammar and Punctuation – Pupils will continue to develop their use of punctuation including colons, semi-colon and hyphens.											
Writing – Pupils will learn how to make fictional diary entries based on The Children of Willesden Lane. They will practice using emotive and figurative language and time adverbials to write their own diary entries. Later in the term they will develop their composition of 'Character descriptions' and then study 'Newspaper Report Writing'.											
Chosen Texts – The Children of Willesden Lane by Mona Golabek, Lee Cohen. This will be used as stimulus for both writing and reading tasks.											
Religious Education											
Our first topic in RE is 'The Kingdom of God'. The children will reflect on what the Kingdom of God is and what this means for their lives. Our second topic is 'Justice'. Children will understand what justice means and they will learn about inspirational people who fought for justice.											
Science											
Children will be learning about how animals and human's function. They will learn the main parts of the circulatory system and describe the functions of the heart and blood. Children will also be studying and learning will learn about fossils and evolution.											
Geography											
The children will learn about The United Kingdom, studying and comparing the different countries that make up the UK, major cities and the physical features within each country. Children will also learn about sustainable development and how the UK uses renewable energy sources.											
History											
Children will gain an understanding of the different aspects of WW2 this term. They will focus on the citizens of England and how they rallied to defend their isle and live through very difficult conditions. They will study different historical sources including: primary, secondary and propaganda.											
Computing											
Coding Children will learn how to use different systems to plan and code their own text-based adventure game. Children will develop an understanding of how to input commands, use flowcharts to test and debug a program and use code to generate visual effects.											
Music											
This term's focus is 'Keyboards'. The children will: Learn the song 'Boom Chikka' Learn the fundamentals of keyboard playing. Learn to perform and compose on the keyboard using the C major scale, including some Christmas music.	PE & Sport
