

# Continents & Oceans

I should already know:

> The world is made up of many countries.

> Large amounts of water are called oceans.

> That the UK is in Europe.

The countries in the world are grouped into continents.

Some of the continents are joined by land.

The large amounts of water between each continent are called oceans.

Others are separated by oceans.

The **seven continents**:  
Antarctica, Africa, Asia, Europe, North America, Oceania and South America.

The **five oceans**:  
Atlantic, Arctic, Indian, Pacific and Southern.



Key vocabulary:

**continent** — a very large area of land.

**equator** — an invisible line around the middle of the Earth that is exactly half way between the North and South pole.

**hemisphere** — the half of the globe.

**ocean** — a huge area of salty water.

**Human features** of a place are made by **people**.

**Physical features** of a place are created by **nature**.
