Year 1 Curriculum Overview

English

Spelling – weekly spelling tests focussing on that week's phonics learning, plus common exception words
Grammar and Punctuation – Pupils will continue to focus on the correct use of capital letters, full stops and spaces between words. They will focus on using suffixes
Writing – Pupils will continue to develop their use of adjectives to write setting descriptions and begin to use conjunctions more accurately. They will also write short stories, reports and diary entries. We will continue to use the 'Reading Dogs' to support the pupils' comprehension skills.
