The final message from Cardinal Giovanni Battista Re at Pope Francis' Funeral Mass

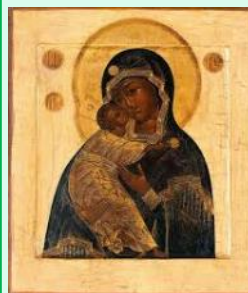
