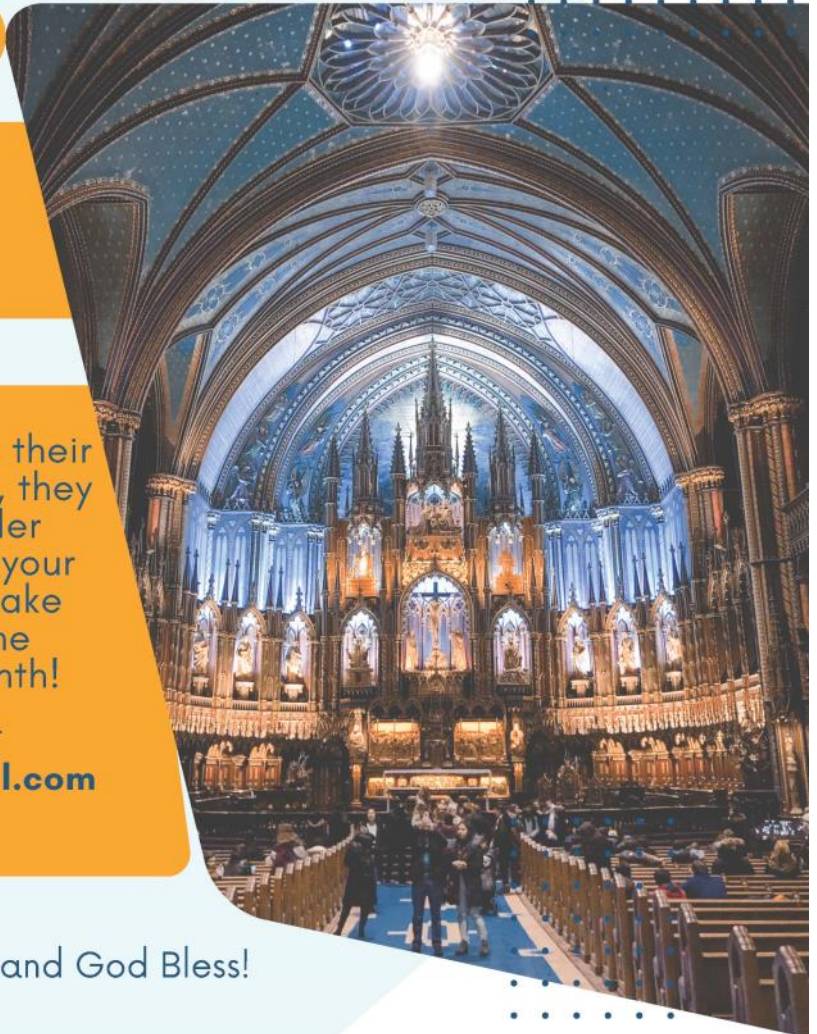

The importance of developing early language is linked to better reading skills.

We would encourage parents to have a look at the [BBC Tiny Happy People](#) campaign which includes resources and information for parents to tackle the high levels of children starting school already behind with their language skills. The campaign aims to teach parents about child development and the importance of having fun learning activities at home to build early speech and language skills.

It provides a combination of support and resources to help parents introduce language activities into their daily routines and to repeat it often enough to make a difference.

If you have any concerns about your child's speech and language development, this will be enormously helpful to you.
