Thank you to Monsignor Jeremy who has given each child a palm cross for Easter. We also welcome Father Jude, our assistant priest, to our parish and school.

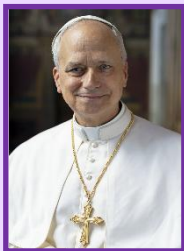
It has certainly been a very busy term and we look forward to the chance to relax and re-energise over the next two weeks.

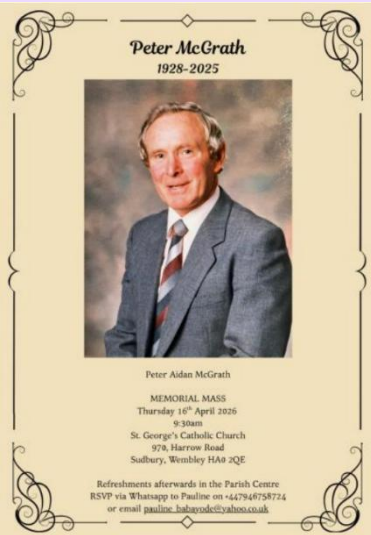

### LEAVE REQUESTS

Requests for leave of absence due to exceptional circumstances must be submitted using the appropriate form, which can be collected from the office this must have supported evidence.

Each application will be considered individually and reviewed by Mrs Monaghan in line with school policy and statutory guidance.

There will be a single consistent national threshold for when a penalty notice must be considered by all schools in England of 10 sessions (usually equivalent to 5 school days) of unauthorised absence within a rolling 10 school week period.

These sessions do not have to be consecutive and can be made up of a combination of any type of unauthorised absence.

### School Uniform– Summer Term

Boys are **not** permitted to have close shaved hair or designs shaved on their heads.

Jumpers and cardigans **MUST** have school logo.



**Boys:** Red polo shirt with grey trousers/shorts and Navy jumper.

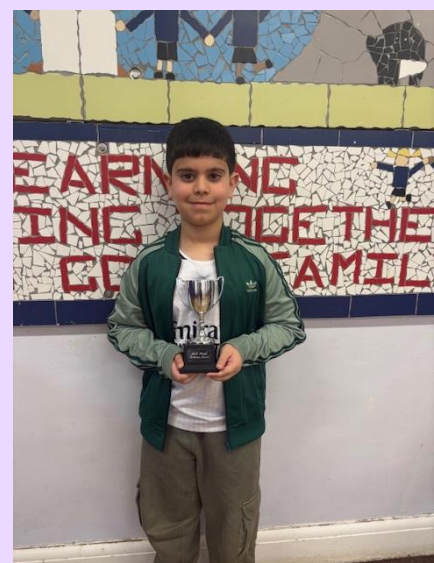

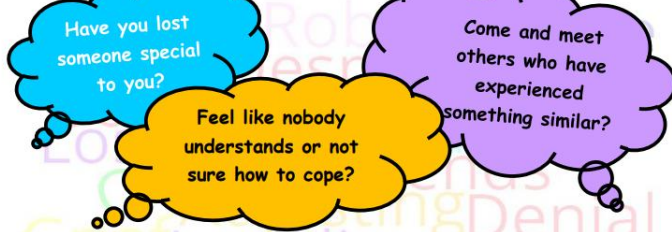
