Change to school uniform providers

Dear Parents,

I am writing to inform you about the plan to launch our school onto the Earth Uniform service on Friday 24th March 2023.

We have made this decision due to the ongoing unsatisfactory service from our current school uniform stockists.

This is to coincide with changing to summer uniform after the Easter break. I have been assured that all summer uniform is available.

It is worth noting that all our house ties and PE tracksuit are available also.

Key points about the service:

- ◆ Order online by visiting www.earthuniform.com
- ◆ Standard UK delivery by Royal Mail will take up to 5 working days
- ◆ The cost of standard delivery is £4.95 but free delivery on all orders exceeding £60
- ◆ Postage of returns free of charge. You should use the original packing and the reusable bag your order arrived in. There is a returns form included in all parcels and this will need to be completed for any refunds.

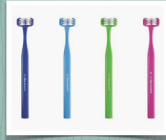
