The Marvellous Makers Summer Reading Challenge continues at Harrow Libraries this weekend with fun and immersive family workshops with the Royal Collection Trust.

In our Windsor Castle Workshops at Stanmore library (8 Stanmore Hill, Stanmore, HA7 3BQ) we will be discovering the story of the oldest, inhabited castle in the world, from ancient wooden fortress to stone palace. There will be a chance to take part in role-play activities and see artefacts and replica regalia from the Royal Collections, including child-sized armour and shields. Children will be encouraged to imagine what it was like to be trained to be a knight - such as a Knight of the Garter - and to live by their code of chivalry through role-play and dressing-up.
