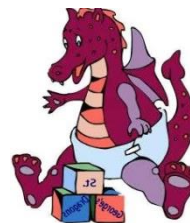

### WHO ARE WE:

St. George's Dragons is non-profit making provision run by St. George's school. The primary aim of Dragons is to provide a quality childcare and education service to families in the local community.

We offer full and sessional day care for children aged between two and five years old. From Monday to Friday between 8.am- 5.55 pm, 49 weeks of the year excluding bank holidays and staff training days.

We are open to the local community and are proud of our rich cultural and social mixture of family backgrounds.

We have a highly qualified and experienced staff team all of whom hold or are working towards several recognised childcare/education qualifications. These include national vocational qualifications levels 2 and 3 as well as BA Honors degrees.

Our intention is to help children to develop through their play, to gain knowledge and experiences, which will be relevant to their development and future in a rapidly changing world.

At St. George's Dragons we work within the Early Years Foundation Stage offering a rich and stimulating learning environment which aims to provide a differentiated curriculum to meet the needs of the children within our setting.

By building on your child's existing interest and skills, we enable them to learn from the activities they are involved. Through this they will discover the worlds of communication, language and literacy, science and technology, problem solving ,numeracy and reasoning, arts, crafts music and drama.

Above all we are pleased to have created a welcoming atmosphere of trust and happiness where our children feel secure and cared for. We are proud to give the children who attend St. George's Dragons Early Years a learning experience that is both positive and fun. Our Current Ofsted rating is : **GOOD 2017**

## ADMISSIONS CRITERIA:

**St. George's Nursery -Dragons is open Monday to Friday 8 am to 5.55 pm to children aged 2 to 5 years.**

We have 30 places. Where there are more applications than the number of places available, these will be offered according to the following order of priority:

1. To children with special educational medical needs or a child in the care of a Local Authority.
2. To children whose parents are employed by St George's and working more than 17.5 hours per week.
3. To children from practicing Catholic families whose parents request sessions on a five-day basis.
4. To children whose parents request sessions on a five-day basis.
5. To children from practicing Catholic families whose parents live and work in the parish of St George's with siblings in Dragons.
6. To children who have siblings attending St George's Dragons whose parents live within the parish of St George's
7. To children who have siblings attending St George's School whose parents live within the parish of St George's
8. Children with siblings attending Dragons whose parents live and work in the parish of St George's.
9. To children with siblings attending Dragons whose parents do not live or work in the parish of St George's.
10. To children whose parents live and work within the parish of St George's without siblings attending Dragons.
11. To children whose parents work in Educational settings in the London Borough of Harrow but outside St George's parish.
12. To children whose parents work in an educational setting outside St George's parish and the London Borough of Harrow.

**Please note: MORNING and AFTERNOON places are allocated on an ALL YEAR ROUND BASIS.**

**GOVERNMENT FUNDING:**

**Nursery Education Grant Entitlement - 15 & 30 Hours Funding**

Children are entitled to the NEG after the term of their 3rd birthday.

There is no cost for access to the NEG Entitlement, fees only occur for any additional hours , meals or services incurred after your child's allocated funded hours.

**Free Early Years Childcare for 2 Year Olds**

You may qualify for free early years childcare for your two year old If you are in receipt of certain benefits, or have an income below around £16,000 per year.

Our terms and conditions have been set with the aim of protecting the interests of everyone concerned with success and continued operation of the nursery. They are intended to provide a practical working basis for the contract agreed between us and parents who use our service.

1. The signed registration agreement signifies an acceptance of all these terms and conditions.
2. Our fees, terms and conditions are reviewed and maybe subject to change each September.
3. A deposit of £200.00 and a £50.00 non-refundable registration fee must be paid upon acceptance of a place, this covers the cost of administration, a credit check, if necessary, home visit, and a welcome pack. If your child attends St George's Nursery Dragons for less than eight weeks and you choose to give less than eight weeks notice this will result in 75% of the deposit being retained. Notice that you no longer wish to use the service at St George's Nursery Dragons is required in writing.
4. On registration the child's original birth and Baptismal certificate (if applicable), Parent identification and a recent utility bills as proof of address must be provided before a child is accepted in to the nursery.
5. Fees are calculated using the standard hourly rate as printed on our current Fees Price List.
6. The Nursery will not be open until 8.30 on Friday mornings for staff meetings.
7. Fees must be paid in full regardless of sickness or holiday. We do not waive fees when a child is on holiday or absent due to illness.
8. Fees are invoiced monthly and payment is due on or prior to the first day of every month ,using the on line payment system.
9. We reserve the right to withdraw a nursery place due to unpaid or late payment of fees. A fee of £15.00 may be charged on continued late payment of fees.
10. Any application to alter, increase or reduce contracted sessions must be made in writing, using the NOTICE FORMS and addressed to the Nursery Manager. This written notice will then form an amendment to the original registration agreement. Eight weeks clear notice must be provided if you wish to reduce your sessions An application can only be considered should the preferred sessions be available.
11. Parents and carers must ensure that children are brought to, and collected from, the Nursery promptly at the times agreed.
12. Late collection of your child beyond the agreed departure time will incur a charge of **£1.00 per 1 minute**. If you are unavoidably delayed at collection time, please contact the nursery to let us know as soon as possible. Continued late arrival /collection of your child, non-attendance could result in the loss of your child's place at the nursery.
13. **Contracting Parents:** One or both parents will be asked to sign the application form accepting the standard terms and conditions of the nursery. Where only one parent signs the form, the nursery will see this parent as the contracting parent. The contracting parent will be liable for the payment of nursery fees and costs. Continued late or non payment of nursery fees may result in suspension or the loss of your child's place at the nursery.
14. The Nursery Management reserves the right to refuse entry to the nursery.

The nursery **will not** accept any child before 8 am and reserves the right to refuse admission to any child who arrives before the expected time for their arrival without prior agreement.

The Management have the right to review a child's place at the nursery, should your circumstances change.

## **WHAT NEXT:**

Upon receipt of your child's application form their details will be processed and put onto our computerised waiting list.

Please note; length of time on our waiting list is not a consideration for offering a place. When a place becomes available that meets your requirements, your application will be considered using the admissions criteria.

If your application is successful you will be firstly contacted by telephone to confirm your acceptance of the place and then you will receive written confirmation usually via email within seven working days.

A £200.00 deposit and a £50.00 non refundable registration fee must be paid upon acceptance of a place, this covers the cost of administration, a credit check, if necessary, home visit, and a welcome pack.

Unfortunately due to the vast numbers of children on our waiting list we are unable to contact those families to whom we are unable to offer a place.

You are welcome to call us at any time to make an enquiry, or to update us with any changes in circumstances that may affect your application.
